



Privacy Policy

Personal information (personal data) is any information relating to an identifiable individual. Your name, age, email address, home or correspondence address, medical conditions declared, are all examples of personal data.

Out in the Hills collects and processes personal data in pursuit of our legitimate interest to offer and safely provide single-day or multi-day events to you, to provide after-sales service, and to gather feedback in order to improve our service.

Any personal data held by us will only be shared with a third party in the following situations:

- where we are legally required to do so;
- with the emergency services in the event of an emergency;
- with our insurers, technical advisors, and professional and legal representatives, in the event of any near-miss, incident or legal action;
- or where we have your express consent to do so.

You have the right to ask us at any time to disclose to you any personal data we have about you and to correct any information that is incorrect.

You have the right to request that we delete your personal information.

We maintain appropriate technical and organisational security measures to protect personal data from loss, unauthorised access and misuse. Correspondence will normally be via email, but if you would prefer to use an encrypted service, then we also use WhatsApp.

We will retain data about you until the end of any period required or permitted by applicable laws. In general, we will not retain your personal data longer than is necessary for the purposes for which it was collected.
